UPDATED JESUSITA FIRE EVACUATION ORDER

An **Evacuation Order** has been issued for the area west of the existing evacuation area to include all areas north of US Highway 101 and east of Turnpike Road.

MANDATORY EVACUATION ORDERS

- THE MANDATORY EVACUATION ORDER AREAS NOW INCLUDE: Turnpike (western boundary) north of US Highway 101, along US Highway 101 to State Street and Calle Real Intersection, east along State Street to Constance Avenue, Constance Avenue to Garden Street, Garden Street to Micheltorena Street, Micheltorena Street north to the end of the road, extending to Alameda Padre Serra, Alameda Padre Serra, east to Sycamore Canyon Road (eastern boundary), north on Sycamore Canyon Road to Highway 192 (Stanwood Drive) to El Cielito.

EVACUATION WARNINGS

- THE EVACUATION WARNING/ADVISORY AREA NOW INCLUDE: Fairview Avenue (western boundary), from Fairview Avenue and US Highway 101 east along Highway 101 to Turnpike Road north along Turnpike Road to Cathedral Oaks Road (northern boundary).
- AND areas in the City of Santa Barbara south of the Mandatory evacuation area north of State Street from San Roque Road to De La Vina Street, De La Vina Street, to Anapamu Street, Anapamu Street to Anacapa Street, Anacapa Street south to De La Guerra Street, De La Guerra Street to Milpas Street, Milpas Street south to Quinientos Street, Quinientos Street to Clifton Street to Eucalyptus Hill Road, Eucalyptus Hill Road to Barker Pass Road, Barker Pass Road to Highway 192 (Sycamore Canyon Road), Highway 192 (Sycamore Canyon Road) west to Stanwood Drive.

Jesusita Fire County Call Center Closed

Due to the above Mandatory Evacuation Order, the County Call Center has shut down to relocate overnight. Calls made to (805) 681-5197 will no longer be answered. A new telephone numbers will be distributed for the Call Center when it reopens in the morning in a future press release.

Helicopter Refilling Operations at Dos Pueblos High School

The Air Operations Division of the fire response will be conducting water filling operations at Dos Pueblos High School (7266 Alameda Avenue – Goleta) overnight. While no fire suppression activities are scheduled to occur at this time, residents should expect noise and overflights of firefighting helicopters overnight. The American Red Cross Evacuation Shelter will remain operational.
