Repopulation/Re-entry Description
Tea Fire

Effective 6:00 p.m., November 17, 2008, the Tea Fire mandatory evacuation order will be modified. The only remaining mandatory evacuation areas will be:

- West Mountain Drive between El Cielito Road and Coyote Road
- Gibraltar Road north of El Cielito Road to East Camino Cielo

The mandatory evacuation order will be lifted for the residents of the following streets:

- Camino Alto
- Conejo Lane
- Conejo Road
- Ealand Place
- Orizaba Lane
- Sherman Road

The utility companies are still actively diagnosing and repairing infrastructure within the Mountain Drive and Gibraltar Road areas. Southern California Edison currently projects having this work completed by Wednesday, 11-19-08 at 6:00PM. Once power has been restored and the area is deemed safe, the public will be notified that these areas will open and residents will be allowed to return.
